

# Marek Maciejczyk

**Marek Maciejczyk** (born 1975) is a Polish graphic artist, illustrator, and poster designer, winner of numerous international graphic design competitions. His works, inspired by the traditions of the Polish School of Poster, are characterized by minimalism, content synthesis, and social engagement – addressing ecological, cultural, political, and global crisis themes. Maciejczyk's creations are held in museum collections, including the National Museum in Warsaw, galleries, and private collections worldwide. He collaborates with cultural institutions, publishers, and galleries, designing posters, book and audiobook covers, and event visuals.

## Biography and Education

Marek Maciejczyk was born in 1975. He studied at the Institute of Fine Arts in Cieszyn (Faculty of Arts, University of Silesia in Katowice). He is an active representative of contemporary Polish graphic design. His career focuses on the poster as a form of visual narrative, offering distance and reflection on contemporary issues. Maciejczyk draws from the Polish School of Poster, combining rich content in a minimalist form – his works are memorable, subtle, yet sometimes provocatively powerful in thought.
